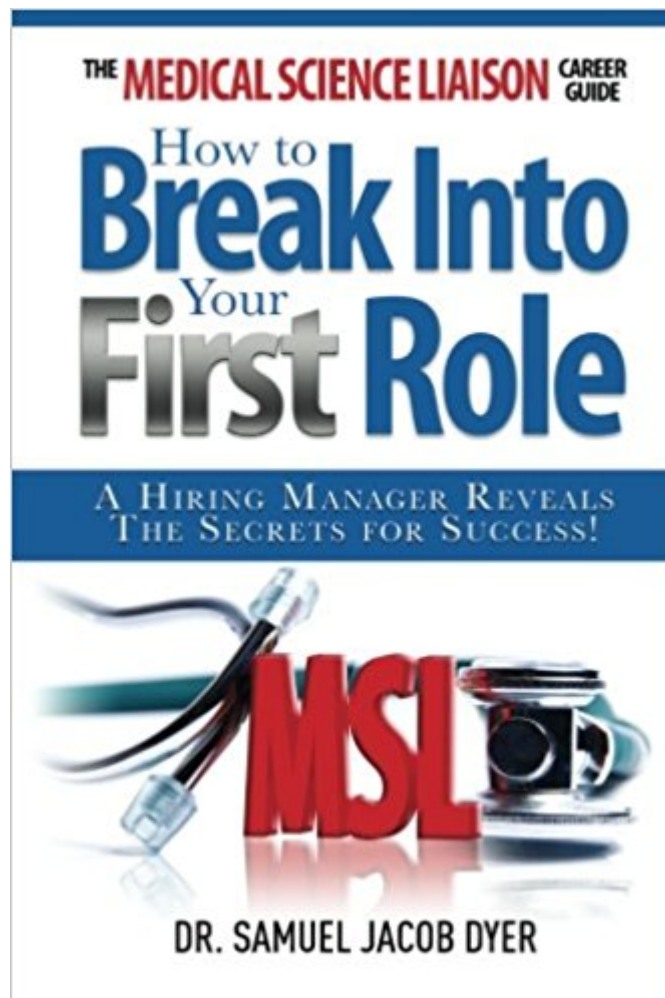

However, I knew I did not want to become a doctor and practice medicine, yet I always imagined having a career that was highly respected and would allow me to be involved with the latest in medical advances. I also wanted a career that was dynamic, global in nature, would allow me to travel, would provide financial rewards, and was in high demand. In 2000, I began my career within the pharmaceutical industry, and I found exactly what I was looking for in the Medical Science Liaison (MSL) role.

Dr. Dyer's guide provided me with a clear picture of what to expect in the hiring process alongside a clear definition and understanding of the role. The book is written concisely, has a clear structure and is free of any redundancy. You can see how his enormous expertise in the MSL field is condensed in this book, both in terms of content and writing style. After all, precise communication skills are crucial for this role. In regards to those negative reviews, a lack of specific examples is not something I see as an issue. What I really like in this book is the layout organized in a simple and logical way: each chapter describes the most crucial steps for the new MSL candidates. What needs to be emphasized is also that Dr.Dyer explicitly points out the value of networking and communication and both are mutually important for a fresh MSL candidate. This led me to Dr. Dyer's book and I was astonished at how accurately he describes each step of the interview process, as if this is the playbook that all hiring managers follow. This book is exactly what I need as I continue my pursuit of becoming an MSL, and it is written precisely the way MSLs communicate - clearly, concisely, and professionally. Having attended one of Dr. Dyer's conferences I can state with certainty he is deeply committed to helping aspiring MSLs succeed and truly passionate about furthering the profession. The contents truly provide a 360° view of how one should prepare for breaking into the MSL career. Dr. Dyer should consider including this aspect in the next version of the book. Overall, I am pleased to have a copy of this book and it has added another dimension to the enthusiasm I have towards this career. I am positive that the guidance provided in this book will take me a step closer in breaking into the MSL role. I strongly encourage those candidates who are aspiring for a MSL career transition to pay attention to the ideas and concepts delivered in this book.
