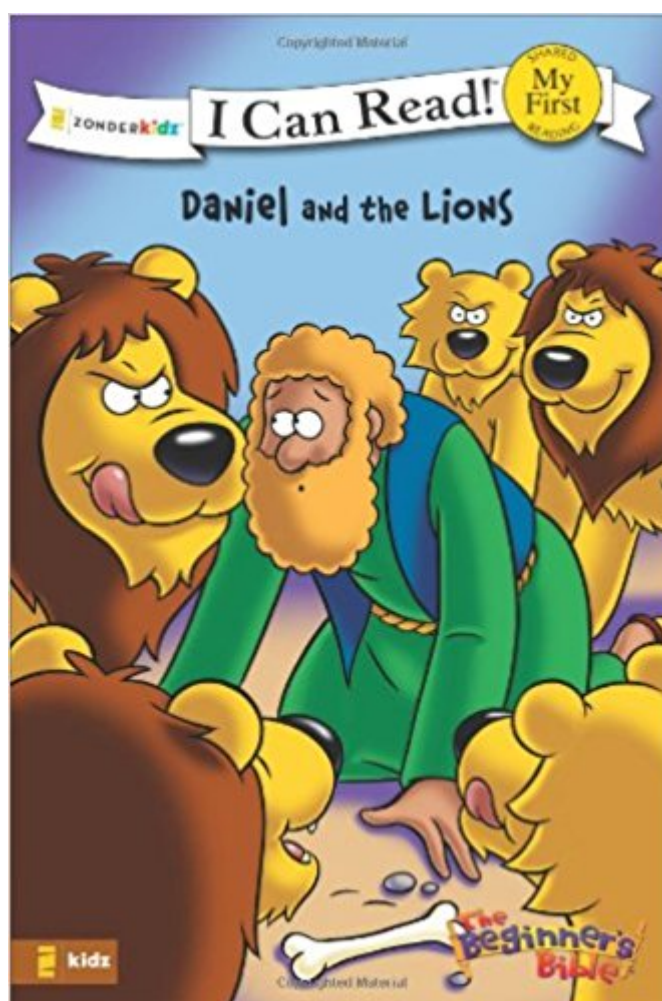

Bought this recently after having bought David and the Giant for my son for Christmas. So this is our second book in the I Can Read! series. I'm blown away at how fast my son is improving in his reading abilities. While it took him a handful of times through David and the Giant to be at a

comfortable level where I didn't have to help him much, with this one he was pretty much there his first time through! That speaks volumes at how these books can help your child learn to read. I'm sure in another few weeks I will pick up another book in the series to add to our small collection, so the rotation will be larger and not so repetitive. But even still, with just the two books we are enamored with how well my son is reading! The book itself has wonderful pictures, and like David and the Giant, takes a story that does have some gore in it and makes it more than appropriate for kids. And yet it still has the core message intact: to serve God and be faithful to Him is more important than following man's established rules. A wonderful introduction to Biblical stories. The sentence structure and word selection are also age appropriate for the most part (a few words that take some explaining and getting used to...but hey - those are learning opportunities!) Overall, I couldn't be happier with these books. Can't wait to get more!

I have bought these books for me to read to my 4 (and now 5) year old son. They are Biblically accurate, and he knows his Bible stories better than most kids as a result. We got our first book in this series when my son was 3, and he quickly memorized it, which tells me he really likes them. They are worth having as books that he will eventually read to himself, and that his sister (now 2.5) will eventually read too.

I love these simple Bible story first reader books. We have a set, but it didn't come with Daniel so I had to add it to our collection. They aren't always completely accurate, but it's a good starting point for little kids.

My five year old son loves this series. The price is low, the illustrations are charming, and the text is perfect for getting the story across in easy to read words. The length is perfect for a new reader and the author picked entertaining stories from the bible. Also, Christian parents who want to supplement otherwise purely secular public school teaching can get some early bible education in at home with this series.
