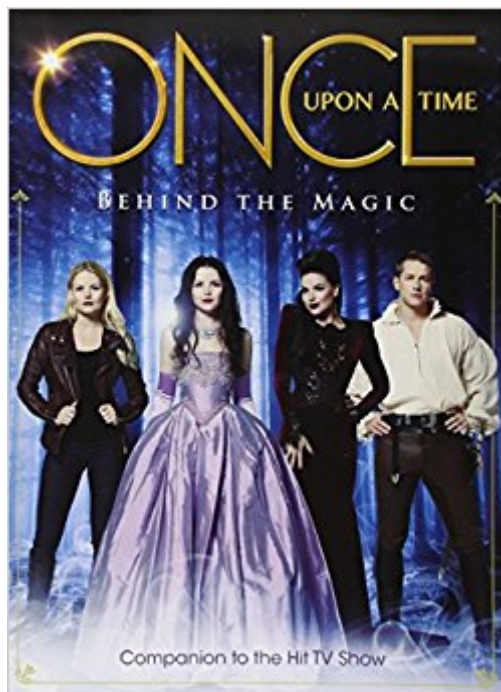

This book is a combination of the two Titan magazines about Once Upon a Time. It is the exact same information with just a few extra features like the entire Season 2 guide and a one or two other small things. If you already own the two magazines, you might want to skip purchasing this book (further down the line the books will be better and more updated, purchase those) or sell your magazines and buy this book. I don't want to ruin this for anyone, but fair warning: At the price they sell these, it is something to consider. But purchasing either this book or the two magazines instead, would be equally good purchases.

We like Once Upon a Time, and find that it is a topic we can share in conversation with much younger family members. I bought the book as I was impressed with the series both in storyline and in filming. This is a good way to get a peek behind the scenes for the "how do they do it" aspect of the show. Also included are nice interviews with many of the main characters, lovely stills from both the show and behind scenes, and a synopsis of each episode from series one and two. We are hoping that a second volume will be coming out for this highly different but entertaining season three.

I love this TV series and this book is a must have. Did not expect it to be so choke full of colored stills and insights into the actors, the characters and heaps of behind the scenes (i.e. the special effects, the costumes, and a full synopsis of all episodes in seasons 1 and 2). From what I have read, this is a reprint of the Once Upon A Time magazine, and since I did not get them, I am pleased they released it in this format. Highly recommended for ardent fans....
