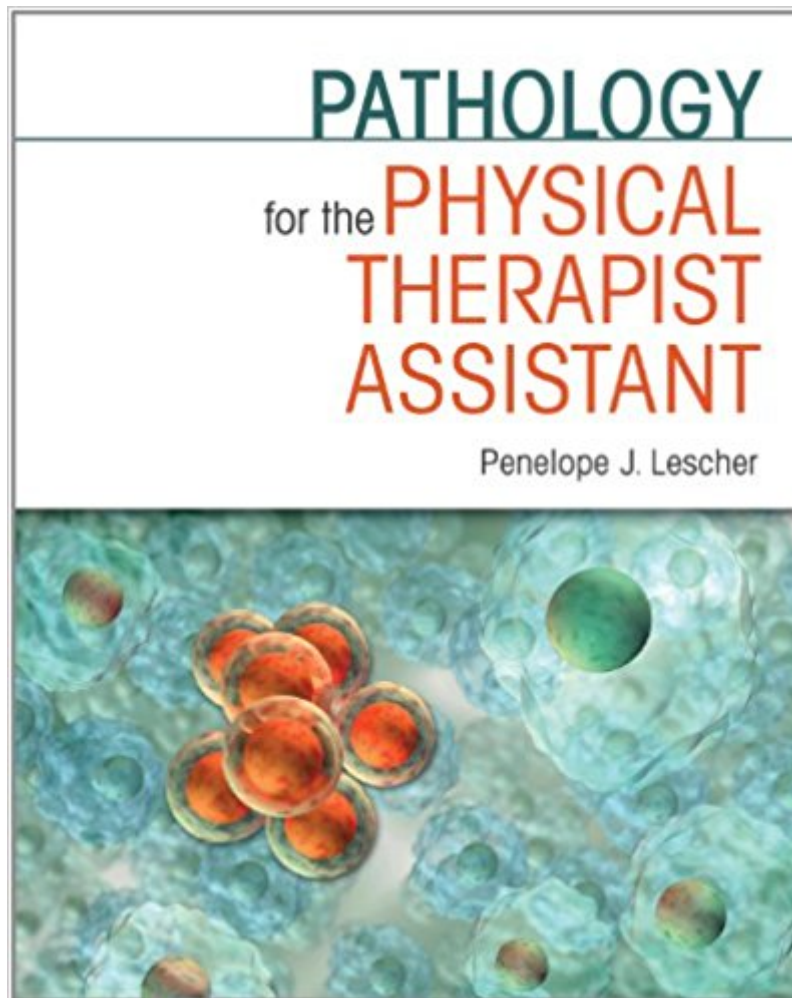

This book is full of information, examples, charts, and helpful pictures; however, the book reads like a repetitive run on sentence. You also get a massive amount of information in a section that has little to do with the topic then the next topic is exactly that useless bit from the last topic cut and pasted. An editor would be nice. As well as bold terms with defined definitions. It is also hard to find information because of the lack of bold terms. Hard to look back and find information in the book as well without having to reread a whole chapter or section of a chapter.

Transaction was fine. The text appears as a series of copy and pasting entries as many phrases repeat one another, sometimes within the same paragraph. It covers a TON of content, so

specificity suffers, but the editors could have consolidated many statements throughout. Also, more diagrams will help the reader. This book relies too heavily on straight text. Still, as a quick reference and not a definitive guide, this book suits its purposes.
