The book goes into very detail information about the Andean Culture and history with Plenty of High Quality Pictures. I bought this book for a class and it was actually readable. It got a little wordy at times, but it's an academic book so that is to be expected. I liked how the author mixed the art with the history and blended it together with images so the information stuck.
