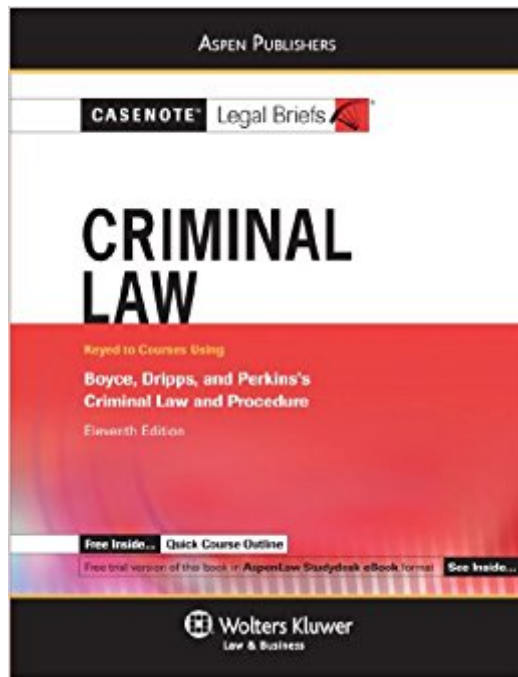


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This has been incredibly helpful when briefing cases. Of course I brief on my own and then use this to "check my work."

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
