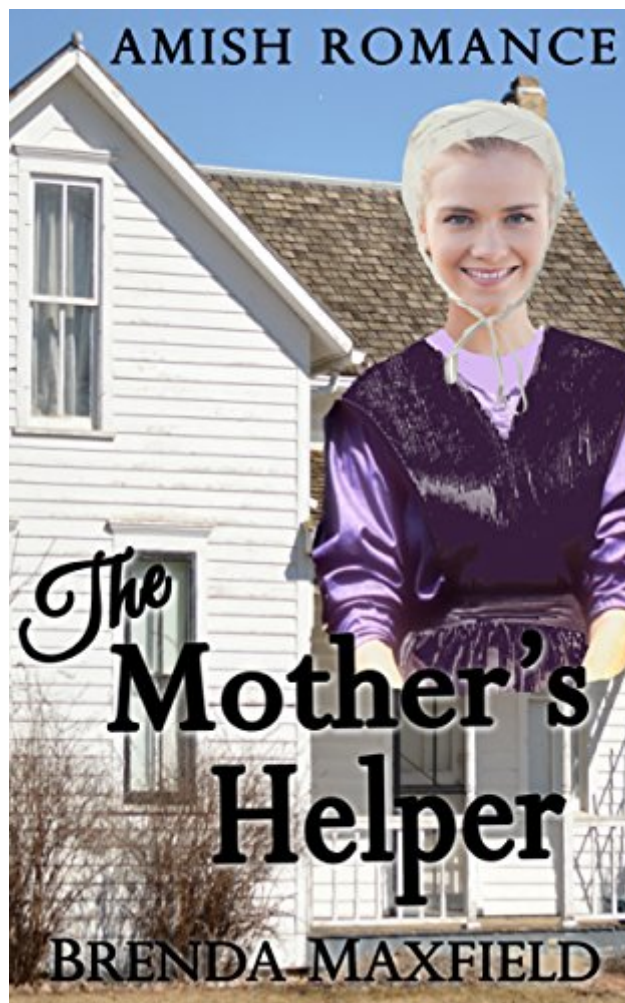




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Amish Romance: The Mother's Helper (Nancy's Story Book 1)

I used to read a lot of Amish novels, but haven't read one for some time. I thought I would give this short story a try and see what the author can do with it. The book page gives the outline of the story, so I don't need to go into that too much. As the book opens, Nancy is cuddling a baby, trying hard not to cry. The baby is the son of her cousin, Irene, and Nancy wishes the child were hers, and that reminds her of her lost beau. That night she has an unexpected encounter with a stranger in her bedroom, who turns out to be Luke Rapp, a friend of the family whose usual bedroom at the house just happens to be the one now occupied by Nancy. I was drawn into the story and enjoyed the author's brief description of springtime, and became caught up in the give and take of family life and other relationships. Also interesting are the little snippets about Indiana that are scattered through the book, nothing major, just interesting bits and pieces that are woven into the story. Ms Maxfield has a subtle sense of humour and there are sentences dotted throughout the book that brought a smile to my face. This is a well-written and edited story. I was a bit disappointed it isn't complete in itself but continues in another book, although I did know that when I bought it, but human nature is perverse. This is an enjoyable story of human relationships, family expectations and obligations, of deep feelings, and the freedom that forgiveness brings, with touches of humour and romance. Recommend, but remember it has a follow-up book.
