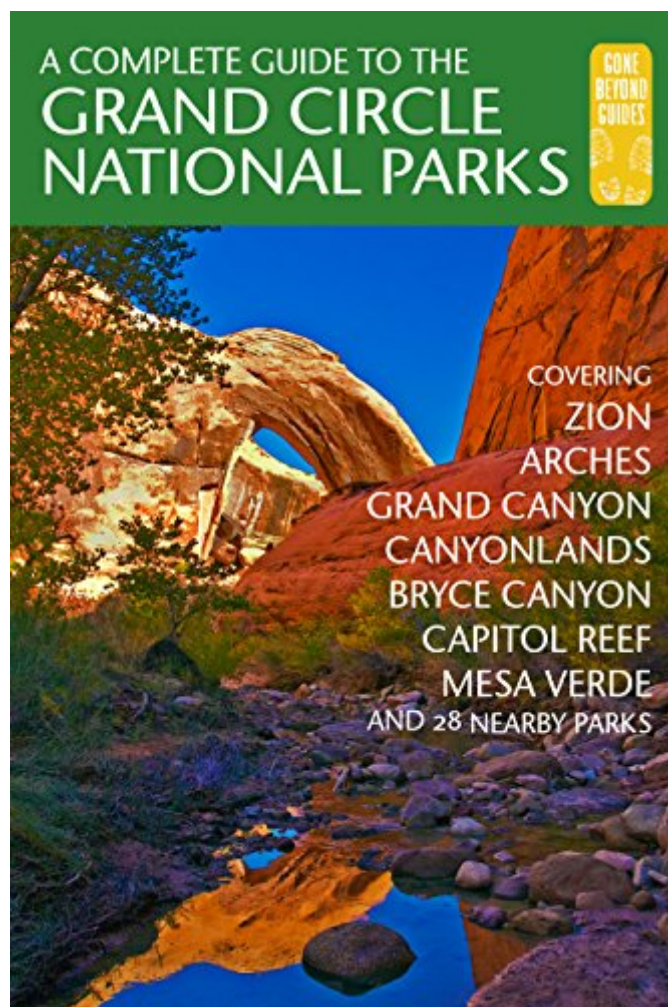

We just completed the Grand Circle trip and this guidebook was our essential go to! As moderately fit hikers with a 11 and 14 yo, it had the perfect combination of different length hikes for us to do and other tips. The stories are a very nice touch. Get this guide and do it!

We used this book as our guidebook on a recent family trip around the Grand Circle. Ours was less ambitious -- just Zion, Bryce and Grand Canyon, as we wanted less driving time and more time in each place. A couple of thoughts:1. We flew in and out of Las Vegas, as suggested, with our 9 and 12 year old boys. Based on the book's recommendations, we stayed at the Flamingo, but I would really NOT recommend it for families: it is pretty old and showing its age, there is a lot of foot traffic inside, which brings a lot of smoking and people drinking on the go. And most critically: 3/4 of the pools on the property are 21+, including all the pools with waterslides. So we were stuck at one older pool that was only about 4 feet deep. And they were blasting pretty raunchy music the whole time -- we were uncomfortable and the kids did not have a great time. Perhaps the other hotels work out better, but we wish we'd avoided this one.2. The trails recommended in the book are also the most popular ones advertised in the parks, so you'll get a lot of the same info from the Visitor's Center. Be wary of Angel's Landing in Zion unless you are very experience hikers -- it's very very

steep with precipitous drops, and also incredibly crowded, which makes it even more harrowing -- you often have to wait long stretches hang off the side for people coming down by you or going up past you.

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
