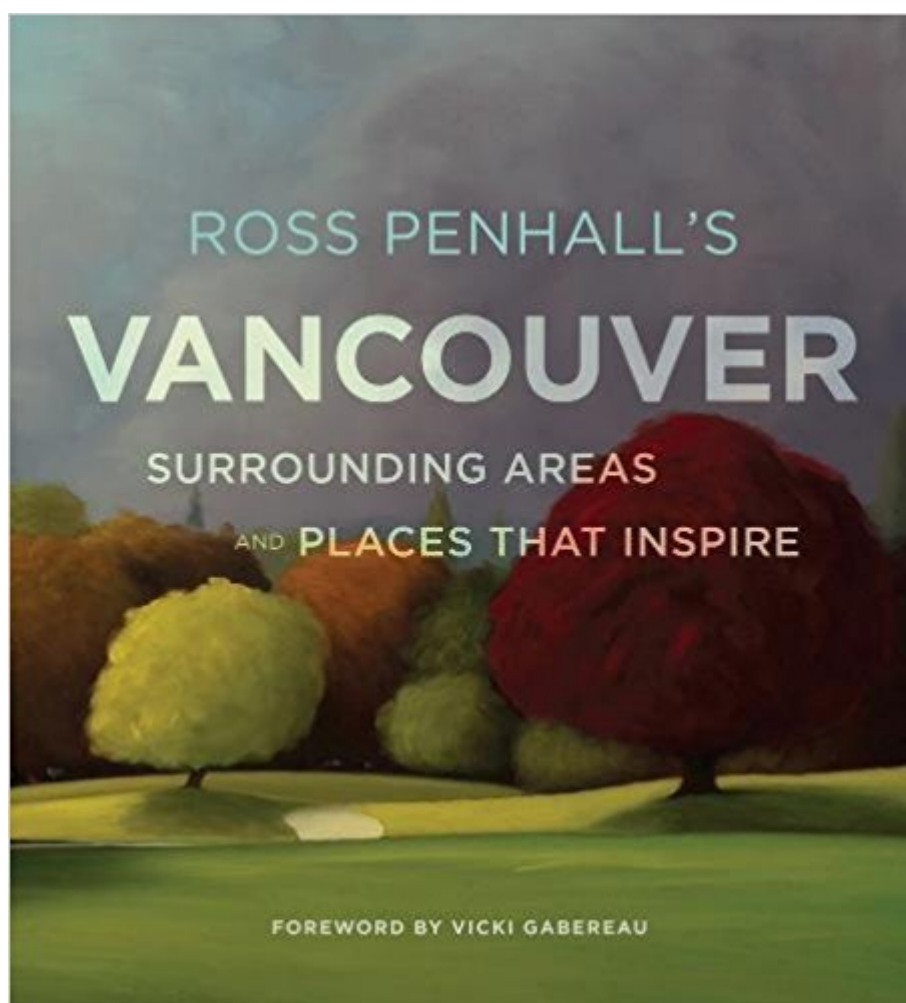

Visitors and residents alike will look at Vancouver in a new way after they see it from Ross' unique perspective. Whether it's a row of hedges on the corner of someone's yard or the cascading rocks at Spanish Banks, Ross finds endless inspiration in the city where he lives. In addition to paintings of Vancouver, there is a chapter on Surrounding Areas that focuses on the scenery of the Interior, Vancouver Island and Coastal British Columbia. The final chapter, Places That Inspire, includes paintings of the Pacific Northwest of the United States, the Canadian Prairies and landscapes from Ross' travels abroad. For lovers of art, for lovers of Vancouver and for anyone who looks for beauty in the everyday world, Ross Penhall's Vancouver is a book that will continue to captivate readers long after they first open it.

ROSS PENHALL is an internationally acclaimed artist whose work is represented by Gallery Jones in Vancouver and Caldwell Snyder in the United States. Ross was born in Vancouver and attended art school at Emily Carr University of Art and Design and at Capilano College. He worked as a

firefighter for almost 29 years and retired in 2010. Ross paints full time at his studio in North Vancouver. He has two grown children and lives in Horseshoe Bay with his wife Caron Penhall.

I've been a HUGE fan of Ross Penhall's art since I saw it featured in an art magazine a decade ago. For years I've craved a Ross Penhall ... but I'm not eligible for original paintings that cost thousands of dollars, and he didn't have any posters/ giclees ... until now! Now I can, and soon will, frame several of his pieces. They'll be smaller pieces (size 8"x10" and smaller), but that's waaaaaay better than nothing, which is what I had before. (Well, other than the image I scanned from the magazine and have used on my home computer's "wallpaper.") I am SO GLAD he made a beautiful coffee table book. Something about the style and colors of his trees, grasses, shade/light, with the occasional road thrown in, really makes something in my brain buzz with happiness.
