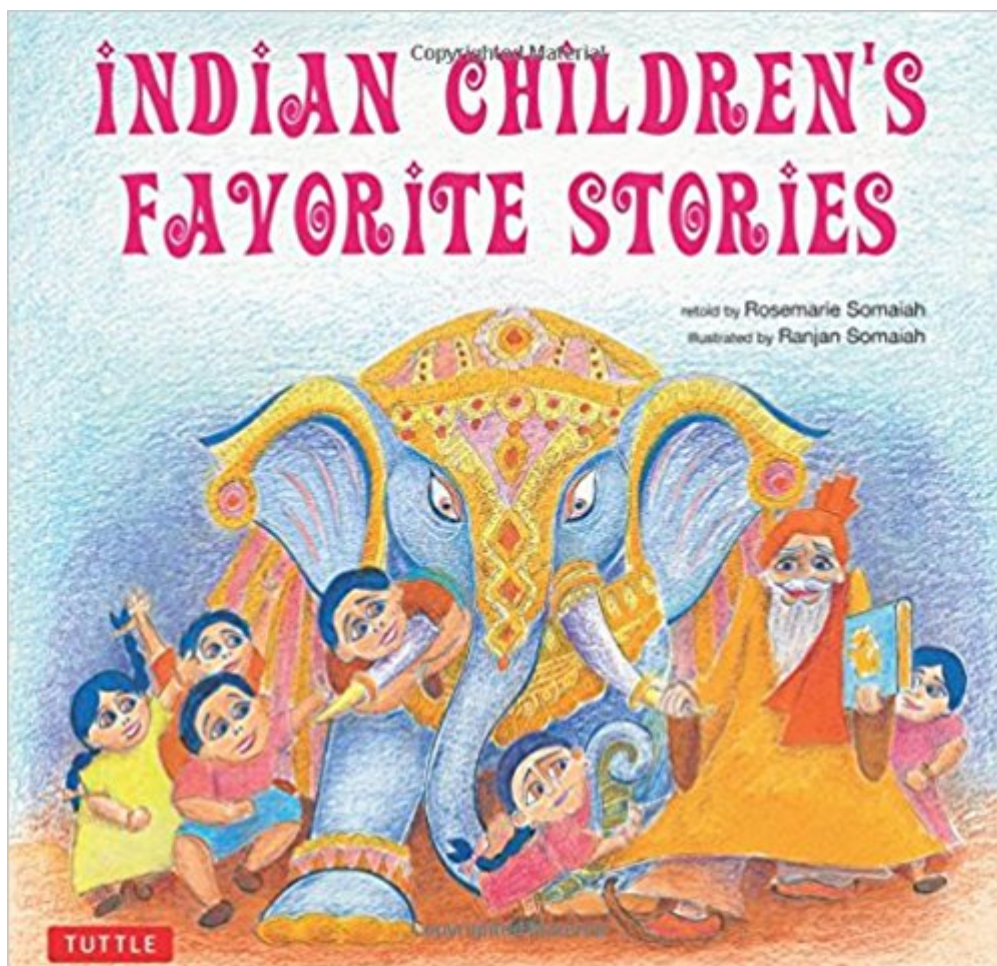




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# Indian Children's Favorite Stories

These are good stories, but the cover is a bit deceptive: these are not stories for the primary grades so much as they are for lower intermediate (i.e., 12 to 14 year olds.) The story concepts are fairly complex, and the length of the stories -- and syntax -- are far beyond the attention skills of your average 6 year old.

Wonderful collection, beautifully retold with artistic illustrations that depict the story very well. I got this for my 6 year old daughter and she loves it. Highly recommended for kids anywhere in the world.
