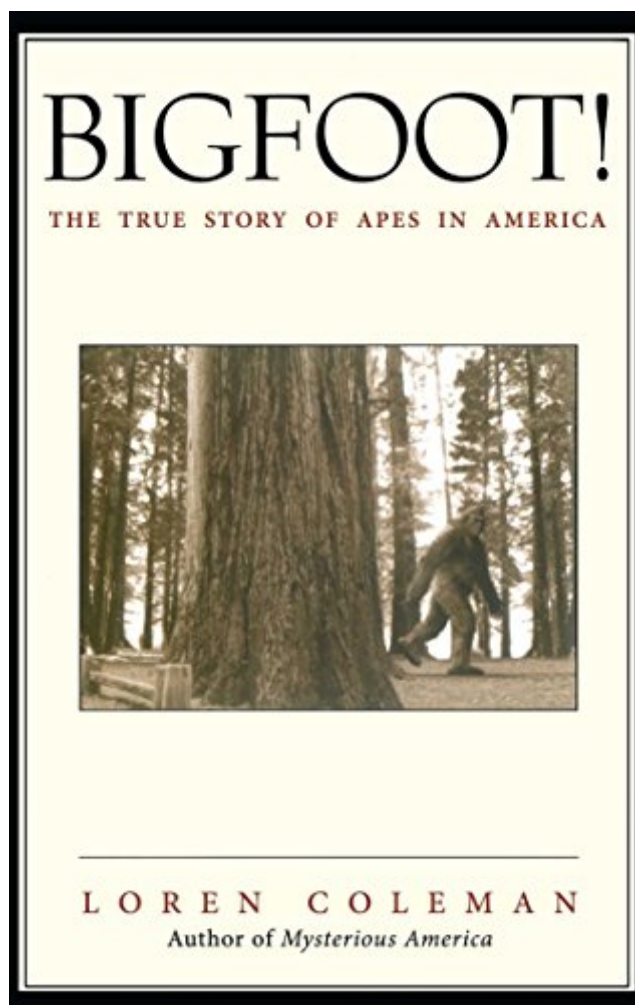


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Bigfoot!: The True Story Of Apes In America

This was a good read. There is a lot of history in here about the search for Bigfoot that can help a modern investigator understand the background of what has gone before. Some of Loren's views may be a little controversial but it is definitely food for thought. Anyone interested in Bigfoot will likely enjoy this book. Note that a very large bibliography is in the back so the book isn't quite as long as you think when you first pick it up or see it on Kindle.

My take: Worth the read, but a little disjointed in the approach. Some good information, but the writing and subject matter seems to jump around a bit a times. To the author's favor, he is obviously a recognized player in the bigfooting field, and has done extensive research over many years. Also, he seems to make a commendable effort to give credit where credit is due, as he mentions (by name) other figures - both known and not so well known - in the bigfooting community. Overall, a fun read, and one of the better books out there in this subject area.
