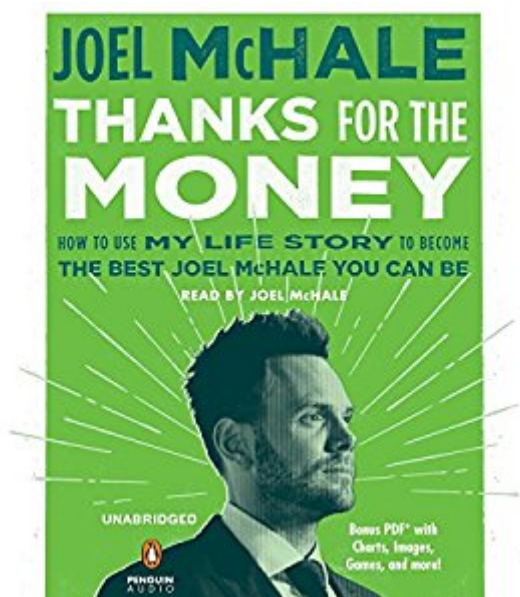


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Thanks For The Money: How To Use My Life Story To Become The Best Joel McHale You Can Be

This book was everything I had hoped for in a Joel Mchale memoir. If you enjoy Joel and appreciate

his snarky sense of humor then you won't be disappointed. I've read many celebrity memoirs and I can confidently say that beneath the sarcasm and laugh-out-loud humor this is probably one of the most honest depictions of fame that I've ever read. It's smart and hysterical. I highly recommend it.

I was very disappointed by this book. Although I like Joel McHale, his humor gets old quickly (as does looking at footnotes). I got to the point where I was only reading two chapters at a time and then only one. At 50% through I finally gave up and bought something new, but I may come back to it later. I was hoping for a bit more on the *Almost Live* days, but he really skimmed over that as if he was ashamed of it. The best part was probably the chapter where his wife kept popping in with comments.

I wasn't sure what to expect from this book; I haven't read any celebrity books, so I had no prior experience with anything in this genre. It took me a couple of chapters to really catch on to his style and the purpose of the book. Overall, I really enjoyed it, and it was a quick read. It would have been nice to have borrowed it from a library, though, or even just paid a little less, but that's just being nitpicky about price. If you're a fan of Joel McHale, chances are you'll enjoy it!

Joel's snark is better on screen than in a book, but the book is amusing. If you're a fan of his work, the best way to read it is by imagining him actually making the snarky asides. If you're newly a fan, this is a great introduction to Joel's world, but it may not click with you.

I don't watch much on TV except the late night humor shows (the next day, online), so never heard of Joel McHale until I came across a video from *Late Night with Seth Meyers* on which McHale was a guest. I was intrigued by his personality and sense of humor, so I went looking for his other videos, including clips from *Soup* and *Community*. Somewhere along the line, his book was promoted, so I bought that too. I wasn't disappointed at all. His style is totally different from any celebrity "memoir" I've read. The term "LOL" is overused, but I did, several times.
