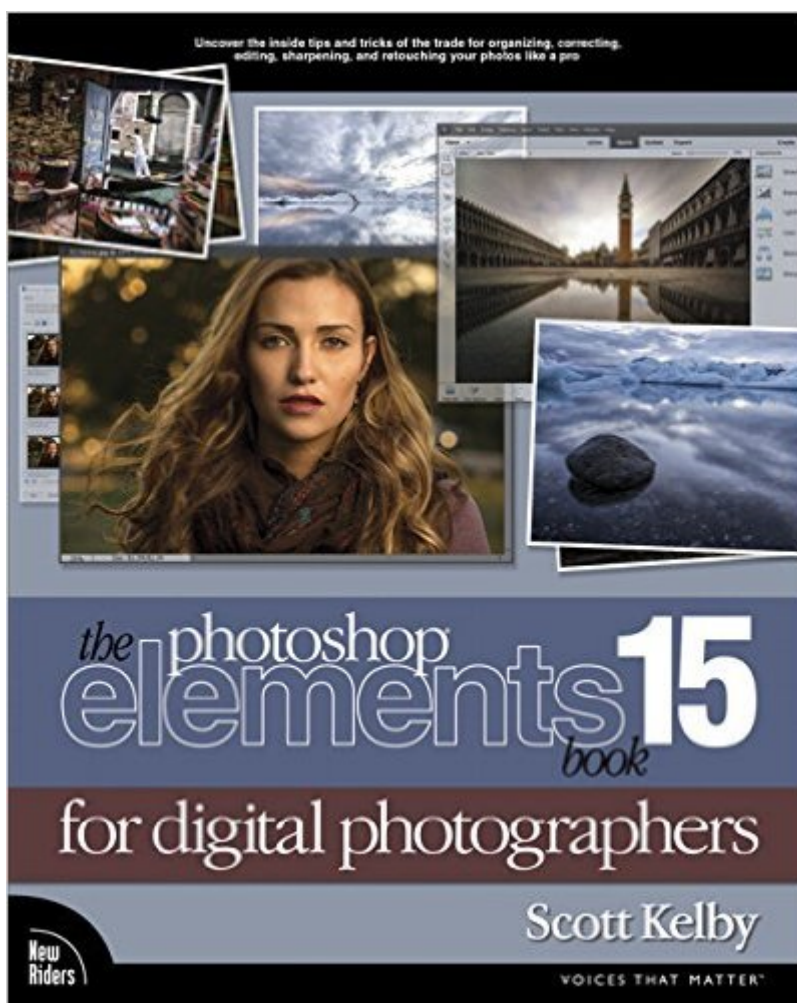

It's all Elements, step by step, cover to cover, in the only book of its kind, and you're gonna love it!
